BEACON LANE, WOODNESBOROUGH

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow works to be carried out to provide utility services to a new property, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Beacon Lane, Woodnesborough.

A closure is planned from Monday 8 October 2018 for an estimated period of up to 5 days.

Beacon Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of 'Fairways', with no through access between the junctions with Beacon Hill Road and Marshborough Road.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Drainless Road and Foxborough Hill.

Access to the remainder of Beacon Lane continues from a western direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, the road will need to remain closed outside the working hours.
